ARTS

- Holy Family Bookstore is the foremost supplier of guality Catholic religious material in the San Gabriel Valley.
- **Soup'n Cinema** is a shared simple meal, an opportunity to view a movie and a discussion to follow.
- **Visual Artists** share their talents to enhance their faith experience and that of their fellow parishioners through a variety of means and media in the liturgy and beyond.
- **Writers** are needed to communicate the mission of Holy Family on our website, in the bulletin, for the school and for special events

ADULT EDUCATION

- Bible Study provides a stimulating, enlightened and praverful approach to the study of sacred Scripture.
- Confirmation allows Catholics who have not received this sacrament to complete their initiation/sacraments.
- Lenten Faith Sessions: Living Eucharist is an opportunity for small groups to gather for prayer and refection throughout the Lenten period.
- Living With Christ Retreat is a Thursday and Friday evening, and Saturday morning retreat which focuses on our call to be faith filled disciples of lesus Christ.
- + Living Your Gifts is a five week seminar based on Clifton's Strengthfinders assessment of gifts and talents.
- Parish Mission hosts a special speaker each winter to lead the parish in faith renewal.
- + RCIA (adults, teens, children) The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) welcomes new members and provides appropriate spiritual formation according to each person's needs.
- **ReMembering Church** is a place for returning Catholics to explore their faith and future with the Church.
- Spiritual Direction assists those who seek guidance, affirmation, and/or enrichment in their spiritual experience.

BEAUTIFICATION MINISTRIES

- Church Environment helps to create a space which enhances our encounter with the living God through our liturgies.
- Garden Ministry oversees maintenance of the landscaping and plans seasonal color.
- **Environmental Ministry** seeks to educate and inspire others to act out of reverence and respect for God's creation by promoting sustainable living and responsible stewardship of our resources.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRIES

- + Altar Servers help facilitate our Eucharistic liturgies in a regular and reverent manner, open to anyone who has entered the fifth grade or older.
- Boy Scouts offers responsible fun and adventure, develops character and self-reliance, stresses personal responsibility, provides opportunities for prayer and encourages spiritual growth.
- Cub Scouts helps a young boy (grades 1 through 5) grow up to be a self-reliant, caring individual of worth to his community and his church.
- **EDGE** Middle Schoolers meet weekly to learn about our Catholic Faith. They perform community service and host social nights.
- Liturgy of the Word for Children allows children to leave the assembly during the Liturgy of the Word and gather elsewhere to celebrate the Liturgy.
- Religious Education Program spreads the Good News of Jesus Christ to our students and their families.
- Safeguard the Chidren is a comprehensive program designed to promote a safe environment for children, youth, and vulnerable adults.

- Sunday Preschool provides preschool and kindergarten age children with a religious program and spiritual environment
- **Toddler Co-Op** provides toddlers an opportunity to learn about God's gifts through spirit-filled play, crafts, stories and songs, giving parents an opportunity to attend Sunday 9:30 a.m. Mass.

COMPUTERS & TECHNOLOGY

- Communications and Technology Committee oversees the website, social networking and other electronic media, assuring appropriate integration of Holy Family's mission
- Database Committee meets on an ad hoc basis to discuss any operational issues with the parish database.
- Video Ministry / Holy Family Productions volunteers produce high-quality videos of Eucharistic celebrations as well as Holy Family events, special liturgies, and other activities.

COMMISSIONS

- Administration lends expertise and practical assistance in providing stewardship of physical assets, overseeing parish operations.
- Community Life provides a welcoming, hospitable atmosphere throughout the parish community.
- Education / Formation supports all levels of faith formation; encouraging all to participate in life-long spiritual formation
- Outreach provides servant leadership for all parish groups and ministries that reach out beyond the people who come to church.
- Worship coordinates all aspects of prayer and worship.

- Dolores Mission is Holy Family's "sister-parish" in the Boyle Heights section of East Los Angeles.
- Eucharistic Ministers to the Sick bring Eucharist to the sick, elderly and the home-bound.

- Get on the Bus annually brings children and their guardians to visit their mothers and fathers in prison.
